Hi, my name is Debra. I am 32 years old, and was born in Puerto Rico. I was raised in the projects. My life was filled with drugs, gangs, and violence. The circles I traveled in had a “golden rule” called “sin”. I was a violent teenager, having tried marijuana at 16, I started using more drugs, and began to sell them as well. I made money by beating people up for pay. I stole, and did carjackings. I started using harder drugs. My life was spiraling out of control and so was the crime and violence I was involved with. I was careless, mean and dangerous. I was an outcast in my town, so I left to come to the United States. I did stay clean and sober for a period of time. After a while, I returned to Puerto Rico, and before long, the vicious cycle started all over again. This time was worse than before. I had a career at that point in my life, but then I lost it, along with my family. I lost my sense of “self” and at a point of desperation, in my brokenness and defeat, I cried out to the Lord asking for help. In an instant, God lifted me out of the dark place I was in, and placed me in the hands of a faithful servant. I thank God for Pastor Jorge Abich who sent me to New Life For Girls on August 16, 2010. Today, I am free and healed! Coming to New Life For Girls, and asking Jesus to come into my heart is surely the best decision I have ever made in my life. I have surrendered my life to the Lord and I have accepted His will for myself and for my son. I thank the Lord for the “new life” He has given me to live!

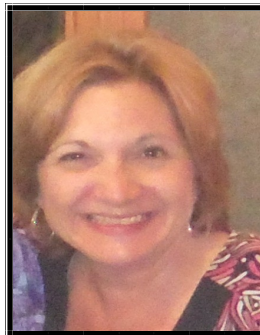
