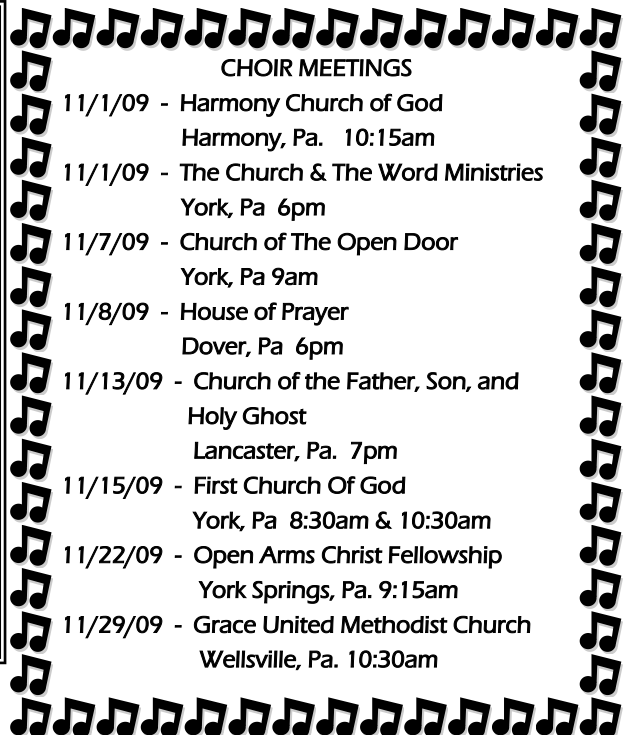
THANKSGIVING DINNER

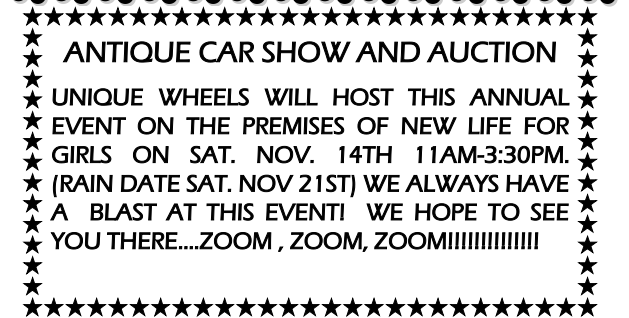
CARMELA'S DREAM

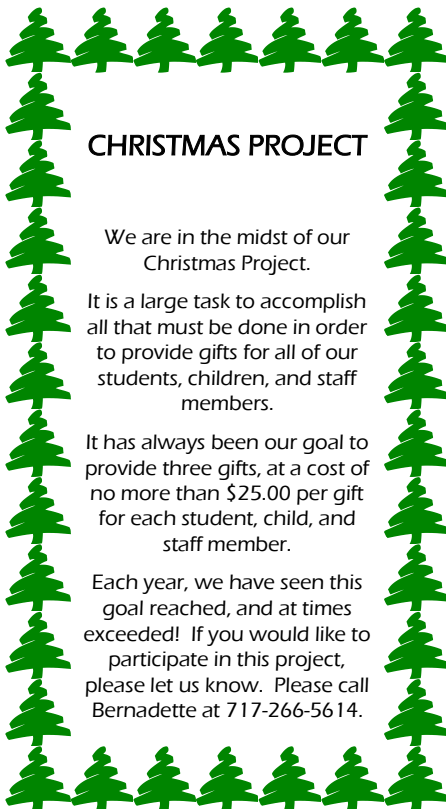
