God had other plans and used my son Adam to get my attention, by reminding me of why life was worth living. I came to realize life was worth living, and that God spared my life for a reason. I remember when I was deep into my addiction, I told God if He would deliver me from the way I was living, I would spend the rest of my life helping other women with the same problems I had. Well, I believe now that God

has taken me up on my word. God has truly given me a heart for hurting women. I am so excited about graduation! After I graduate, I will be remaining at the main center in Dover, Pennsylvania to start my new life in Christ. It is an awesome privilege to be able to remain with the ministry of New Life For Girls. This is the place where God saved my life. Miracles happen here, and I am blessed to be one of them!
